 It teaches us about who lives on earth, the places they created and how each place


differs.

- Asia, Africa, Europe, North America, South America, Australia, and Antarctic




### **Countries**

  - 196 countries make up the 7 continents




# <u>4 Hemispheres – Northern,</u> Western, Southern and Eastern




#### 1) Location

- <u>Absolute</u> <u>a specific location,</u> uses latitude and longitude, an address
- Latitude measures distance north and south of the equator
- Longitude measures distance east and west of the Prime Meridian









## 4) Movement


- People from place to place
