

Perry High School Advanced Dance Agreement

Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

Congrats on being selected to participate in our Advanced Dance program here at Perry! Advanced Dance is a very prestigious class. As advanced program participants, you will need to maintain high standards. My expectations are that students not only carry themselves with respect and citizenship while in class, but also across the Perry campus, outside of school, and at their home studios. You are now a representative of the Perry Dance Program! Class will consist of ballet, modern, and jazz technique, vocabulary, history, choreography, and many performance opportunities. Along with content, students will also learn dance etiquette, audition preparation, responsibility, and leadership. Here are the following expectations for Advanced Dance participants-

1. Time: Rehearsals, performances, field trips, fundraisers, car washes, etc. are all part of being a program participant. These are required events. I am flexible should the occasion arise, but it is up to you to take responsibility for yourself. Please take the “dates to remember” and make arrangements to make sure there are no conflicts. This includes studio, work, doctor appointments, vacation, etc.

****Note:** If you have a conflict with any rehearsal or event and you fail to notify Ms. Miller two weeks ahead of time, there will be no way to make up points lost due to absence. You also risk being taken out of choreography. Conflicts should be communicated via email and in person.

2. Reliability: Students who attend school regularly achieve at higher levels than students who do not have regular attendance. Your success as a class depends upon one another. Please be on time, and willing to always try your hardest. This shows respect for yourself, your class members, and your instructor.
3. Dress Code: The PHS Dance Department’s dress code is black dance pants and black tank or tee shirt. This rule also applies for after school rehearsals. NO shorts or half tops. (Remember you are a steward of the dance program while you are on campus as well!)
