Directions: All sketches are to be numbered, labeled, and dated. The sketches are to fill the page and be filled with shading or color. The sketches are to be of high quality. Sketches are due on BLOCK DAY (unless otherwise instructed) and will be turned in at the beginning of the class period. Late turn in will result in a deduction of points or not accepted. FREE sketches are always paired with another sketch.

Quarter 1

- 1. Zendoodle: complete an image using a variety of patterns.
- 2. Unmade bed: draw a messy bed/bedroom.
- 3. Fruit/vegetables: draw multiple fruits and vegetables that overlap and look realistic.
- 4. FREE sketch: your choice.
- 5. Keys: draw multiple keys with a lot of detail. Make sure they overlap.
