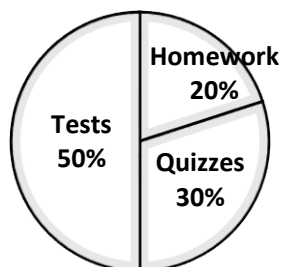

VIRTUAL ATTENDANCE:

HOMEWORK & ASSIGNMENT GUIDELINES:

- Homework is assigned and checked daily.
- Students may receive full credit if they redo the online assignment to get a better score **ONLY** if originally completed and turned in on time.
- HW Assignments are due the day of the next class period. **Do not** go by due dates on HRW or other websites, as those are not accurate.
- **Late** homework is accepted up to the day of its correlating test. Highest score a student can receive on late work is a 70%

If absent, the student has an equal number of days to make up assignments as the days they were absent. It is the student's responsibility to track and make up any work due to absences.

TESTS, QUIZZES & FINALS:

- **Quizzes-**
 - Problems on these quizzes will be similar, if not exact problems from the homework. However, students will not be able to use their homework to complete these.
 - Doing the homework on a regular basis will help significantly for these quizzes
- **Tests** - given usually over 1 module. No extra time allowed on test unless arranged prior to test day.
- **Final Exam** - given at the end of each semester and is comprehensive.

If absent the day of a quiz or test – student will make up the test or quiz the **NEXT** day. If absent for a longer period of time, please make arrangements with the teacher.
