
Jolliffe's Rhetorical Framework Diagram



Surface Features

The Analysis Filters

- 1. Logos (embodied thought)
- 2. Exigence, audience, and purpose (constitute the rhetorical situation)
- 3. Ethos, Pathos, and Logos
- 4. Structure and Arrangement—Examine this in terms of how form(s) serve(s) function(s)
- 5. Surface features (diction, syntax, imagery, and figurative language) and their purpose

Other filters

- a. Modes of discourse: division/classification, definition, comparison/contrast, cause & effect, process analysis
- b. Transitions and discourse markers
- c. Paragraph elaboration and the moves between paragraphs as functioning parts of the language landscape
