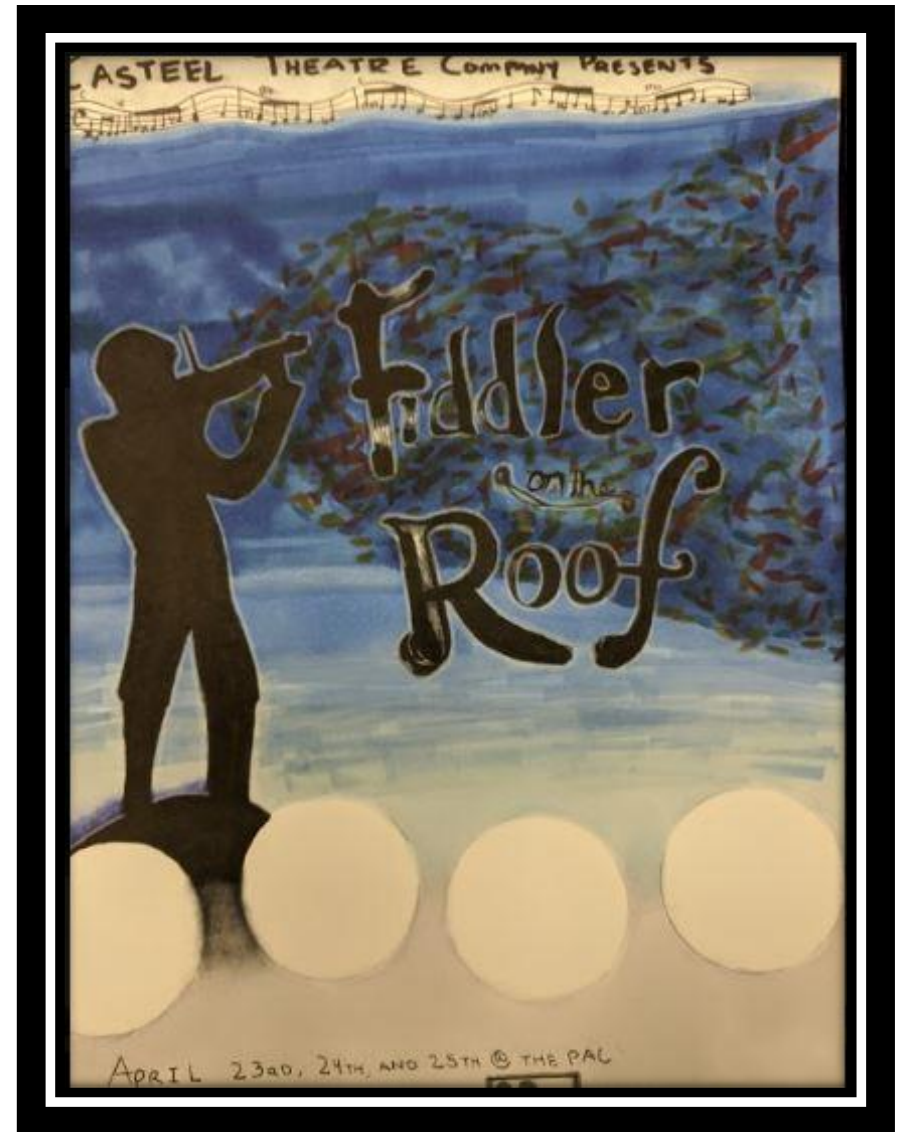


A super big thank you to our amazing Casteel administration and staff!!!

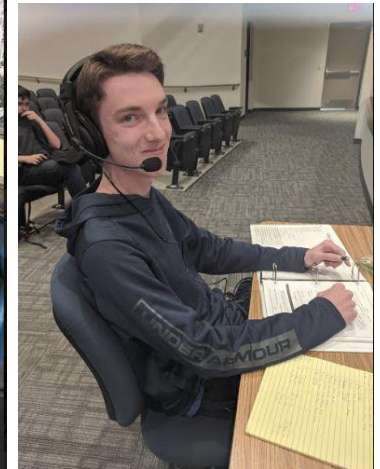

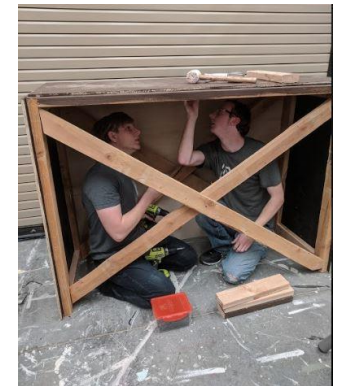

Reagan Russell (Hair and Makeup Head)

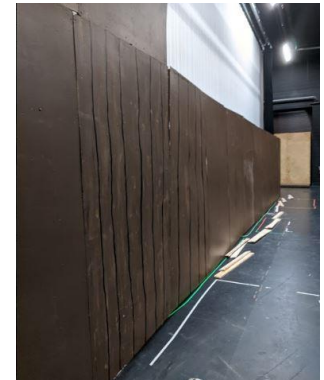

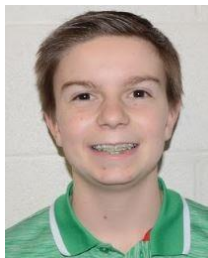
