<u>Tax Credit</u>

Principal Cole discussed our tax credit revenues and expenditures.

- As anticipated, our tax credit revenue/donations were down significantly. We received \$7,700 in donations.
- Our revenue is usually much higher as all of the student extra-curricular fees are deposited into the tax credit account. No fees were charged this year; except for the few students enrolled in clubs, i.e. student council, drama.
- \circ $\;$ If we are able to have field trips next year, student fees will resume.
- We spent approximately \$8,000 out of tax credit for; club t-shirts, club sponsor stipends, Wilson Language Reading materials, 6th Grade end of yearField Trip (the one exception to field trips this year).

Re-Opening Plan for 21/22

As district finalizes the plan for 21/22 families will be notified. We will continue to follow guidelines of the CDC.

- Masks are still required indoors until the mandate expires at the end of May
- Water fountains will remain closed
- o Visitors/volunteers will probably resume, but limited in numbers
- o Frequent hand washing/sanitizing will still be reinforced

- o Large group gatherings outside will be permitted
- Inside group gatherings, awaiting guidelines
- Sanborn considering keeping the "soft start" for 21/22. Students go directly to classroom in morning – no recess.
