## Space Utilization

Caryn attended a meeting last week at district and was given an overview of this project/committee.

- Each school will have 5 people on the committee (2) staff, can be hourly or certified; (2) parents (1) principal. They will attend two meetings next year to help identify which school “might” be repurposed.
- Schools are not closing!
- Several factors are being taken into consideration for repurposing; housing patterns, landlocked neighborhoods, moving patterns, school capacities, etc.
- As people are tending to stay in their homes longer and many areas of Chandler are landlocked, we see a decline in Kinder enrollment....therefore resulting in a decline in overall enrollment.
- CUSD has a Demographer that assists in collecting all data for the committee to review and give their recommendations.
- We have had schools/sites repurposed in the past. Most recently, adding EPA (Elite Performance Academy) to the Humphrey Campus a few years back.

## Principal Transition

Adam McCoy, new principal for 22/23 school year.

- Adam was on campus most of day today. He spent time on the playground during lunch recess, watched parent pick up process, spent time with Caryn and met several staff members.
