

2019 ROTARY FOUR WAY TEST SPEECH CONTEST

On April 9, 2019, at the Sun Lakes Rotary Meeting at Oakwood Country Club, Sun Lakes, AZ, six outstanding students, one from each CUSD high school, will participate in a Rotary Speech Contest. Student speakers will address how the Rotary Four Way Test might be applied to their lives or the lives of others (and especially to their peer group):

Of the things we think, say or do

- Is it the **Truth**?
- Is it **Fair** to all concerned?
- Will it build **Goodwill** and **Better Friendships**?
- Will it Be **Beneficial** to all concerned?

Original speeches are to be 5 to 7 minutes in length and may be delivered by memory or extemporaneously. One small note card is permissible at the local contest. Judges will be from the Rotary District and local club and a sample scoresheet is attached. There will be nominal monetary prizes for participants. Dinner is also included.

Students interested in auditioning to represent CHS must return the interest form below to their English Teacher or Mrs. Templeton by **Wednesday, February 27th**. Speeches will be given in front of CHS judges after school in the JSU on **Wednesday, March 6th** to determine Chandler's representative. Speeches do not have to be memorized for the audition. An audition reminder will be sent to students who sign up. Please see Mrs. Templeton if you have any questions.
