Required Placement (Accuplacer) Testing

Chandler High is offering Accuplacer Testing to our students after school on **May 20th and 21st at 2:20 in the Jones Student Union (Media Center) Computer Lab**. Students must have created an MEID account to be able to take the placement test. This is the link to create an MEID account – <https://admissions.maricopa.edu> (then click on START HERE! Under First time?).

Students will not be able to test unless they bring their CGCC student college ID number (given to them when they create an MEID account) and a photo ID.

Students can also choose to test when convenient for them by going to the **CGCC Campus Test Center whose hours are Monday – Thursday 8:00am – 5:45pm**. Students must check in 2 hours before closing time to be able to test. Students must bring CGCC student college ID number and a photo ID to be able to test. If you don't apply now and decide this fall to take a dual enrollment class, the funds may be gone. There is no commitment to register for classes if your plans change in the fall, but applying now allows you to determine your eligibility and become pre-qualified for funding.

Students must apply now to receive tuition assistance for the dual classes they plan on taking in the 2019-2020 school year.
