What is it? Dual Enrollment is an opportunity for high school students to earn college credit while in high school. Student who choose this opportunity must be enrolled in a college certified teacher's class(es), follow college enrollment processes & pay the college tuition set for that year. PLACEMENT TESTS FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT

*** All testing will be done at home until CGCC reopens to students. ***

In response to COVID-19, in-person Accuplacer exams are not possible at this time. The online EdReady is the platform students will use for the dual enrollment admissions requirement. There are four EdReady placement assessments but dual enrollment

will only be using three: College Reading, EdReady English, and EdReady Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra and Statistics for MAT140, MAT141 and MAT142.
