Seniors who are in need of an additional course for graduation should meet with a counselor and ask about alternative courses.

WOLF DAYS

Students will pick up their schedule during WOLF days. All students should come prepared to pay class fees, prior year debts, lost textbooks (by cash, check, or Visa, MasterCard, and Discover), create a cafeteria account, acquire parking passes, make any necessary schedule corrections, and complete ID photos. WOLF Days schedule is as follows:

Note:

<u>Please allow 1-2 hours out of your day to complete the check-in process</u>; we appreciate your patience. All students should report to the Cafeteria. You are urged to attend on the days specified; parking is available in the student drop off lot. This is located off of California St. north of Chandler Blvd. There is a signal light at California and Chandler Blvd.

What to bring to WOLF Days:

- Cash, check, or credit card (American Express is not accepted) to pay for class fees and any past debt/lost textbooks owed to the Bookstore
- o Parking Permit Form filled out if needed.

Fees

All fees are payable to the Bookstore by cash, check, or Visa, MasterCard, and Discover (minimum amount for card usage is \$10.00). Class fees must be paid by Friday, Aug 4th. During WOLF Days, the Bookstore will be set up in the Cafeteria for your convenience and open for business during all WOLF Days operations. A list of fees can be found on page 4 of this letter. All past debts must be paid and textbooks returned before a parking permit or activity card may be purchased.

Yearbook Purchase

Yearbooks can be purchased direct from Jostens by accessing their website.

The cost for a yearbook is \$60.00 if purchased early. Buy now and save money!

Schedule Corrections

Schedule corrections must be made by July 17th. Some may require parental permission. Corrections will be made for the following reasons only:

- 1. A failure in a course necessitates repeating.
- 2. A course on your schedule was taken in summer school.
- 3. A course is needed immediately to meet graduation requirements.
- 4. Tryouts for athletics and/or performance classes.
- 5. Schedule is incomplete (i.e., less than six classes per semester).

Bus Information

Information regarding bus routes, pick-up times and bus stops will be available in the Cafeteria during WOLF Days. Bus numbers must be assigned before a student ID will be issued.

Student ID

Students will need a current schedule to receive a student ID. As it applies, a bus #, and/or activity card payment are also required before a student ID can be issued. The <u>Usage and Parking Permit forms</u> can be accessed online and via the <u>Student Handbook</u>. We invite you to bookmark this site for quick access to information about Chandler High School and the coming school year.

There is no charge for an ID during the first two weeks of school. Students are required to have their ID with them at all times and be prepared to show them to any school personnel upon request. IDs are needed for textbook checkout. Replacement IDs are \$5.00 payable at the Bookstore.

Parking Permits: (must have a current schedule and all debts cleared with the Bookstore)

Permits are issued on a first come/first served basis. Permits <u>will not be issued</u> to any student with fees or textbooks owed to the Bookstore. No parking permits will be issued to freshmen. **Students and parents should note that Chandler High School is not responsible for theft or vandalism to any vehicles parked on the school lot or streets close to the school.** Students should lock their cars at all times. All cars parked on campus must have the parking permit displayed. Students need to park in the lot color and space number that they have been assigned. When applying for a parking permit the student must have their <u>current school schedule</u>, a valid Arizona driver's license, year of vehicle/plate number, insurance name/policy number/expiration date, and receipt of payment from the Bookstore.

Class Information

Classes begin each day at 7:25 a.m.

A zero hour class begins at 6:30 a.m., and meets every day. Transportation is not provided for zero hour classes.

Seventh hour classes meet after the regular school day. The days and times are determined by the teacher of the particular class. Transportation is not provided for seventh hour classes.

<u>Bell Schedules, School Calendar, Campus Map, and Tax Credit Form</u> will be available in the Student Cafeteria during WOLF Days. They are also available at the Front Desk and <u>online by visiting the CHS Website</u>.

Textbooks

Teachers will distribute textbooks from the classroom. Students must have a current ID to receive a book.

Senior Credit Check

Counselors will meet with each senior during the first quarter to review the student's transcript to make sure that graduation requirements will be met. It is important to note that the responsibility to meet these requirements rest with the student.
