
Ms. Johnson - Music



Some of the skills we will be working on in Music:

Singing - (Echo songs, call & response, AB and ABA forms, rounds, ostinatos, partner songs, descants, harmony, dynamics, tempo, phrasing, diction.)

Music Symbols - (Dynamics, repeat signs, staccato, legato, crescendo, diminuendo, tempo, accent marks, ties and slurs, articulation, chord symbols.)

Instruments - (Percussion instruments like drums, rhythm sticks, shakers, scrapers. String instruments like ukuleles and violins. Wind instruments like recorders. Correct posture for playing instruments.)

Rhythm - (Steady beat, patterns, improvising, time signatures, quarter notes, half notes, whole notes, 8th notes and corresponding rests, syncopation.)

Melody - (Melodic direction, names of notes on the treble staff, intervals, steps, skips, leaps, repeating notes, high and low pitch, following iconic notation.)

Genres & Styles - (Baroque, Romantic, Classical, Rock & Roll, Blues, Country, Folk, Chant, Opera, Mariachi, Jazz, Caribbean, Patriotic, Native American, Spirituals, Ragtime, Irish, Asian, African.)

What can my child expect in Specials during the Virtual Model?

• When will my child receive live Specials lessons?

Every Monday your child will receive one recorded lesson they will go through on their own during their normal grade level Specials time. Tuesday-Friday your child will receive one live lesson with their teacher and peers. Each recorded and live lesson will be an active 20-30 minutes.

- What happens if my child misses their live lesson with their teacher?
 - No need to worry. Students who miss the live lesson will have access to a recorded lesson link with the lesson they missed. Your child may access the recorded lesson and complete the activities on their own.
