## Deadline to enroll in classes: February 22, 2021

### **DETERMINE PLACEMENT**

The colleges utilize multiple options to determine couse placement for students:

- Juniors and seniors can use unweighted GPA of 2.6 or higher. Upload GPA here
- · ACT, SAT, PSAT and AZMerit scores can be uploaded here
- Placement test if needed go to: maricopa.edready.org/home

Students will need to take a placement test if they are:

- A current a high school freshman or sophomore (EdReady College Reading test)
- A current junior or senior doesn't have a high school GPA above 2.6, based on a 4.0 scale

Students wanting to enroll in MAT206 or MAT212, who don't have the college prerequisites will have to use the MAT206+ form located here.



After students have completed Step 1:

- · Go to my.maricopa.edu, log into your Student Center.
- Add your classes\*
- Tuition payment is due at time of enrollment

#### HOW TO TAKE EDREADY PLACEMENT TESTS

EdReady (used for Spring 2021 only) is taken by the student on their home computer. Students have the opportunity to continue taking the placement test until they get the score they need to qualify for a class. To take an EdReady test and to view the Navigation Guide, go to <u>maricopa.edready.org/</u> <u>home</u>.

EdReady Quantitative Reasoning, Alg and Stats Placement is for placement into MAT140, MAT141, or MAT142.

EdReady College Algebra Placement is for placement into MAT150, MAT151 and MAT152

**EdReady College Reading** is used for participation in the Dual Enrollment Program (per State Statute and if you have no other testing).

Accuplacer scores from the last 5 years will be accepted (for Spring 2021 only).

#### TUITION

Payment is due at time of registration. The cost is **\$85** per college credit plus a **\$15** registration fee per semester. **In state**: 12 credits and above will be set at the flat rate of \$1020.00 (Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 only) **Out of state**: up to 6 credits at \$85 per credit (Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 only)

#### **DID YOU KNOW...**

- High school staff are not responsible for communicating class changes. You need to email the Dual Enrollment Department of any changes at <u>dualenrollment@cgc.ed</u>u.
- You can forward your Maricopa email (your official email that you are responsible for) to a personal email account (google.maricopa.edu).
