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Course Content: In Math Year 4, you will be establishing a working knowledge of college-level mathematics and its applications to real-life problems. The course will have an emphasis on understanding mathematical concepts and their applications. The main goal is to show you how mathematics can be applied to your life in meaningful ways. Problem solving in our textbook will include classification, logic, number representation and calculation, Algebraic equations and inequalities, consumer math and financial management, and Trigonometry.

Materials: Paper, pencil, and a TI 83(+) or TI 84(+) calculator (see Ms. Crooker's school website for online options), and a method of getting online (computer, laptop, tablet, smart phone).

Expectations, Procedures, and Tips for Success:
