<b>jugar al básquetbol</b>	to play basketball
<b>jugar al béisbol</b>	to play baseball
<b>jugar al fútbol</b>	to play soccer
<b>jugar al fútbol americano</b>	to play football
<b>jugar al golf</b>	to play golf
<b>jugar al tenis</b>	to play tennis
<b>jugar al vóleibol</b>	to play volleyball

### to describe how someone feels

<b>cansado, -a</b>	tired
<b>contento, -a</b>	happy
<b>enfermo, -a</b>	sick
<b>mal</b>	bad, badly
<b>ocupado, -a</b>	busy
<b>triste</b>	sad

### to tell what time something happens

<b>¿A qué hora?</b>	(At) what time?
<b>a la una</b>	at one (o'clock)
<b>a las ocho</b>	at eight (o'clock)
<b>de la mañana</b>	in the morning
<b>de la noche</b>	in the evening, at night
<b>de la tarde</b>	in the afternoon
<b>esta noche</b>	this evening
<b>esta tarde</b>	this afternoon
<b>este fin de semana</b>	this weekend

### to extend, accept, or decline invitations

<b>conmigo</b>	with me
<b>contigo</b>	with you
<b>(yo) puedo</b>	I can
<b>(tú) puedes</b>	you can
<b>¡Ay! ¡Qué pena!</b>	Oh! What a shame!
<b>¡Genial!</b>	Great!
<b>lo siento</b>	I'm sorry
<b>¡Oye!</b>	Hey!
<b>¡Qué buena idea!</b>	What a good / nice idea!
<b>(yo) quiero</b>	I want
<b>(tú) quieres</b>	you want
<b>¿Te gustaría?</b>	Would you like?
<b>Me gustaría</b>	I would like
<b>Tengo que ____.</b>	I have to ____.
