## WOLF DAYS

**Students will pick up their schedule during WOLF days**. All students should come prepared to pay class fees, prior year debts, lost textbooks (by cash, check, or Visa, MasterCard, and Discover), create a cafeteria account, acquire parking passes, and make any necessary schedule corrections. We will also have computers available for parents to set up a Parent Portal account. A staff member will be available to help with that process in the Jones Student Union.

#### Note:

<u>Please allow 1-2 hours out of your day to complete the check-in process</u>; we appreciate your patience. All students should report to the Jones Student Union. We encourage you to attend on the days specified; parking is available in the student drop off lot. This is located on California St. north of Chandler Blvd. There is a signal light at California and Chandler Blvd.

#### What to bring to WOLF Days:

- Cash, check, or credit card (American Express is not accepted) to pay for class fees and any past debt/lost textbooks owed to the Bookstore

## Fees

All fees are payable to the Bookstore by cash, check, or Visa, MasterCard, and Discover (minimum amount for card usage is \$10.00). Class fees are due by Friday, Aug 2, 2019. During WOLF Days, the Bookstore will be in the Cafeteria for your convenience and open for business during all WOLF Days operations. A list of fees are available on the final pages of this mailing.

#### Yearbook Purchase

Order your <u>Yearbooks</u> direct from Jostens by accessing their website <u>www.jostensyearbooks.com</u>. The cost for a yearbook is \$60.00 if purchased early. Buy now and save money!

#### **Schedule Corrections**

Complete schedule corrections by July 15, 2019. Some may require parental permission. Corrections happen for the following reasons only:

- 1. A failure in a course necessitates repeating.
- 2. A credit is earned during summer school for a course on your schedule.
- 3. A course is needed immediately to meet graduation requirements.
- 4. Tryouts for athletics and/or performance classes.
- 5. Schedule is incomplete (i.e., less than six classes per semester).

#### **Bus Information**

Bus information for eligible riders will be mailed home by Transportation the week of July 4, 2019.

For open enrollment students that request to ride a bus that comes closest to their home, a form is available online under <u>Transportation, then Forms</u>. Parents can fill out the 'Rider Sheet' requesting permission. Confirmation or denial will not be known until a few weeks into the start of school when seat availability can be determined.

Information regarding bus routes, pick-up times and bus stops will be available in the Cafeteria during WOLF Days.

# Student ID

**Student IDs will be taken during the first week of school.** As it applies, a bus #, and/or activity card payment are also required before a student ID is printed.

There is no charge for an ID during the first two weeks of school. Students are required to have their ID with them at all times and be prepared to show them to any school personnel upon request. IDs are necessary for textbook checkout. Replacement IDs are \$5.00 payable at the Bookstore.

## Parking Permits: (must have a current schedule)

<u>Permits</u> are available to purchase on a first come/first served basis. No parking permits are available to freshmen. **Students and parents should note that Chandler High School is not responsible for theft or vandalism to any vehicles parked on the school lot or streets close to the school**. All cars parked on campus must have the parking permit displayed. Students need to park in the lot color and space number assigned. When applying for a parking permit the student must have their <u>current school schedule</u>, a valid Arizona driver's license, year of vehicle/plate number, insurance name/policy number/expiration date, and receipt of payment from the Bookstore.

#### Athletic Clearance

## EMERGENCY AND HEALTH UPDATE

Parents please make sure you have updated your child's Emergency and Health Update in the Parent Portal. This information needs to be up-dated each year. To access this information take the following steps.

- Use your <u>parent portal</u> username and password.
- Find the "Emergency and Health Update" line towards the bottom of the list of options on the left side and click to open.
- Verify the information listed and make corrections as needed. You must click on each section to verify.
- Note: when you read the question regarding emergency transport you must click yes to move on.
- After all sections are completed, your session will end with your signature and submit button.
- You will receive a confirmation number as verification of completion.
- We hope to have every student's emergency information updated by **September 6, 2019**.

#### **Class Information**

Classes begin each day at 7:25 a.m.

A zero hour class begins at 6:30 a.m., and meets every day. Transportation is not available for zero hour classes.

Seventh hour classes meet after the regular school day. The course teacher determines days and times. Transportation is not available for seventh hour classes.

<u>Bell Schedules, School Calendar, and Campus Map</u> will be available in the Student Cafeteria during WOLF Days. They are also available at the Front Desk and online at <u>www.cusd80.com/domain/913</u>.

Students who are meeting with staff/athletics after school can take the late bus at 4:00 pm. Students must have a pass from a staff member to ride the bus.

## New Starting This Year

Effective with the Class of 2020, all CUSD high schools will be using the Cum Laude recognition program. This will replace the concept of designating a valedictorian and salutatorian at graduation. This recognition program will be used to acknowledge the most academic successful students at graduation. More of our outstanding seniors will be recognized than the valedictorian/salutatorian concept allowed. The categories for distinction under the Cum Laude recognition program are as follows:

- Cum Laude—meaning "With Praise"
  - To qualify a student must achieve a 3.75—4.24 GPA
- Magna Cum Laude—meaning "With Great Praise"
  - To qualify a student must achieve a 4.25—4.49 GPA
- Summa Cum Laude—meaning "With the Highest Praise"
  - To qualify a student must achieve a 4.5—5.0 GPA

## **Textbooks**

Teachers will distribute textbooks from the classroom. Students <u>must have</u> a current ID to receive a book.

## Senior Credit Check

Counselors will meet with each senior during the first quarter to review the student's transcript to make sure that graduation requirements are on track. It is important to note that the responsibility to meet these requirements rest with the student.
