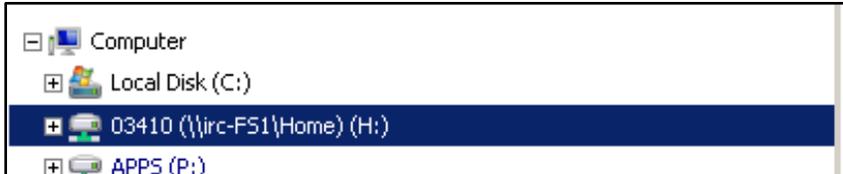


How to Check for and Delete LARGE files in your Network Space

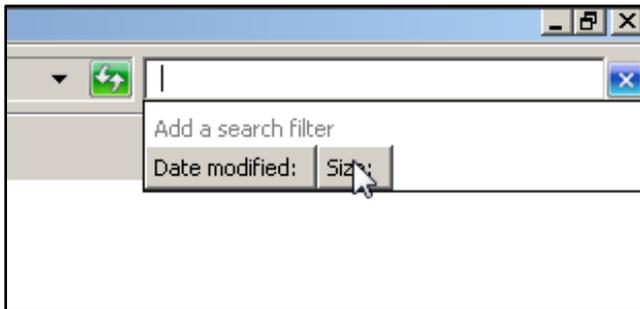
1. Double-click on the Computer icon on your desktop:



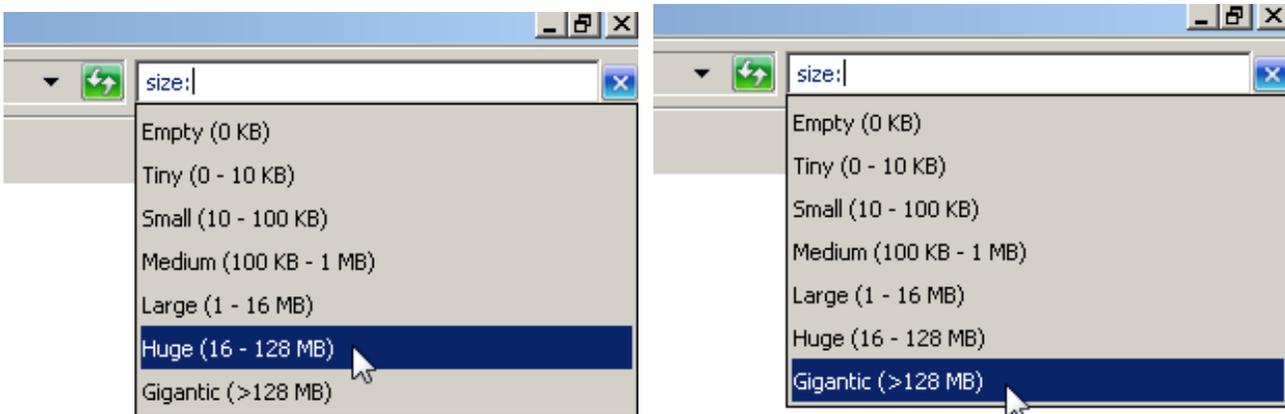
2. Click once on the drive you want to check... your H:\ drive.



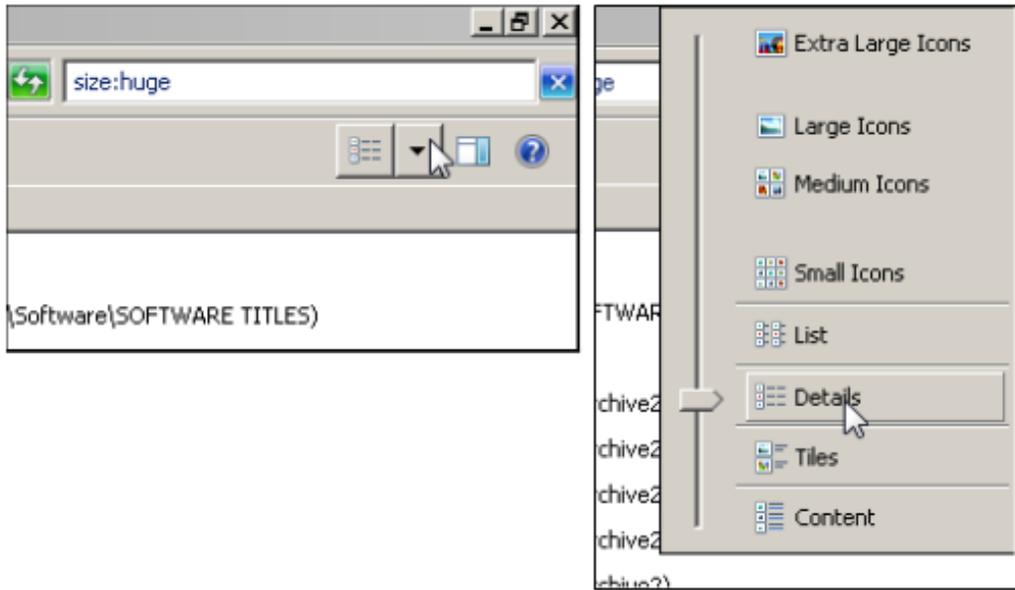
3. On the top right of your window, click in the search box and then on **Size**.



4. Choose the size of file you want to search for... like **Huge** or **Gigantic**.



5. It will start searching immediately. After it is done, click on the drop-down arrow to show the details of each file:



6. Click on the **Size** header to sort by size.

7. Then, click to select any files you want to delete and press the Delete key. (You can use Ctrl-Click to select multiple individual items OR Click and Shift-click to select a range of items.) BE SURE that you don't need the items any longer before you delete, since they won't go to a Recycle bin... they will be gone.
