

Galveston Elementary Parent Involvement Policy

Each school served under Title 1 will involve parents in the planning, review and improvement of the schools programs under Title 1 in an organized, ongoing and timely way.

Galveston School will convene an annual meeting to inform parents of Galveston's participation in the Title 1 program. Galveston school will involve parents in an organized, annual review of the school parent involvement policy and the joint development of any school wide program plan.

Galveston school will provide parents with:

- A. Timely information about the Title 1 program
- B. School performance profiles and annual progress of school toward academic goals
- C. Their child's individual assessment results
- D. A description and explanation of the curriculum in use at the school, the forms of assessment used to measure progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet
- E. Opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions, share experiences with other parents, and participate as appropriate in decisions relating to the education of their children
- F. Timely responses to the suggestions made by parents that have been offered in meetings

If the school wide program plan is not satisfactory to parents, the school will submit any parent comments on the plan when the school makes the plan available.
