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Equity Corner: Spotlight on Hamilton High

Hamilton High School's AP Seminar with African Diaspora content students invited Dr. Sallu to their final group presentations. Students delivered 8-to-10-minute presentations and answered oral defense questions. The groups researched the following topics: the skin whitening industry, discrimination against Black women in the US healthcare system, ethnic studies courses in Arizona, how the model minority myth affects college students, and child trafficking in Nepal. Each group member researched their topic through a different lens (economic,



social/cultural, political, scientific, etc.), and then the groups considered all lenses before proposing a solution. These inspiring young scholars are learning how to find research-based solutions to the world's problems.




