The Chandler Unified School District Governing Board on Wednesday night unanimously voted to name Frank Narducci as the District's Interim Superintendent effective July 1, 2021. As Interim Superintendent, Mr. Narducci will have full authority to lead the District.

CUSD Students Shine at the Arizona State Science Fair




Although Chandler Unified educates only about 3% of the students in Arizona, CUSD students took home more than one third (37%) of the state's award-winning projects at the Arizona Science and Engineering Fair (AzSEF). Additionally, CUSD students represent 48% of the students qualifying for the prestigious Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF). Lastly, CUSD students won 30% of the AzSEF special awards.

AzSEF is the science and engineering fair for the state of Arizona and is managed by Arizona Science Center. AzSEF brings together hundreds of science fair first-place winners from across Arizona to compete for thousands of dollars in prizes and scholarships.


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CEF Raffle Winner Chooses Car
