Infinite Campus & Late Work

- 1. All grades will be posted in Infinite Campus. Yearbook assignments usually have longer due dates because they consist of planning and producing the pages.
- Because of the nature of this class and the responsibilities we have to the school, deadlines must be strictly enforced. Students who turn in work after the assigned deadline may be subject to penalties of up to 50% off their assignment grade depending on the circumstances.
- Late work will not be accepted under any circumstances when there are <u>fewer than two weeks</u> <u>left</u> in the quarter.
- Students are expected to meet deadlines and to contact Ms. Johnson in advance to discuss any issues with due dates.
- 5. If absent, the student must communicate with Ms.
 Johnson regarding the situation and needs for the missing work. The student will receive an "M" (for Missing) in the Infinite Campus gradebook. This means that it will be averaged as a "0" until the assignment is submitted.
- 6. If a student does not turn in the assignment after being reminded twice, it will turn to a zero and cannot be made up for points.
