I am still seeing any number of students NOT in dress code during the week. I am not going to list the Dress Code again for you, as it is clearly stated in the Handbook. I will share the most frequent violations. Please note that your student will receive a Violation Notice for these. More than 1 Violation will result in additional consequences, normally loss of recess time.

- 1. <u>HAIR!—Both boys and girls.</u> Boys' hair cannot be longer than the ear on the sides, above eyebrows in front and completely off the collar in back. Girls must have "growing out" bangs pinned back in some fashion. Hair may not hang down on the face.
- 2. <u>LENGTH OF SHORTS/SKIRTS</u>—must be approximately KNEE LENGTH. Mid-thigh is not acceptable on any age group.
- 3. <u>Friday Shirts</u>—May be **PTO** sponsored shirts or **School Club** shirts. Patriotic shirts must have a red-white or navy blue background color.
- 4. **WARMER WEAR INSIDE CLASSROOMS**—Items like sweatshirts and sweaters must be predominantly red, white and/or navy blue only. They are to be plain and no large logos or writing.
- 5. **TUCK IN THOSE SHIRTS!** Whether you like it or not, that is the rule. Even in Kindergarten!
