

Riggs Elementary Student Council

Thank you for your interest in participating in Student Council! Being part of the Student Council is a great way to serve your school and community.

1. When running for office, each candidate will be allowed a single poster which will be provided by a Student Council sponsor. All posters will be displayed in the main hallway. Posters can be created at home or at school, however, students must use original poster given to them. Anything extra such as t-shirts, buttons, stickers, etc. will not be permitted. Finished posters must be given final approval by a Student Council sponsor.
2. All candidates must have a “C” average or higher in order to participate in Student Council. Failure to maintain this average will result in being placed on probation.
3. Any Student Council member who receives a misconduct ticket will be required to conference with a Student Council sponsor as well as being subject to disciplinary action, which may include probation or removal from office. Final decisions regarding disciplinary action will be decided among the Student Council sponsors and principal.
4. Any Student Council member who receives a misconduct ticket that *requires* a conference with Mrs. Weyenberg will be placed on probation.
5. Any Student Council member who receives a 2nd misconduct ticket that requires a conference with Mrs. Weyenberg will be removed from Student Council for the remainder of the year.
6. Any Student Council member who fails to maintain a “C” average will be placed on probation. Progress will be checked mid-way through the grading period. Students who fail to make academic improvement due to poor work and study habits will be removed from Student Council.
7. Any Student Council member who has more than two unexcused absences from a meeting will not be allowed to attend the District’s Student Council Convention.
8. Student Council members are role models for other students in our school. Members of Student Council need to model good character, which include: responsibility, respect, trustworthiness, caring, citizenship and fairness.
