(Numbers 4-5 to be **specifically explained** in an attached, computer generated document of not more than two (2) pages of double spaced print, size 12 font.)

Eye exams and glasses – we provide funding for Chandler school children in financial need that would otherwise go without. In fiscal year 2011-12 we contributed over \$3,500 of sight.

Camp Tatiyee (AZ) – we provide financial support to the operations of the camp, assist with seasonal grand opening preparations, and sponsor attendees to this summer camp for disabled youth. In addition, we have donated handicapped equipped vehicles.

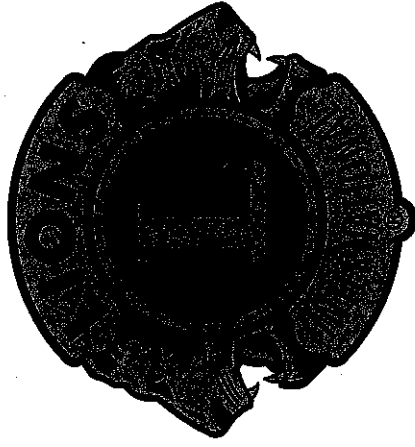

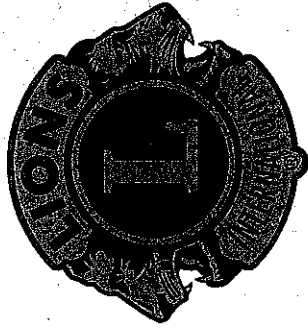
