1.01 Journey 2025 - Effective Resource Management

Land Update

Dr. Casteel shared that Frank Fletcher had made attempts to reach the owners of the two land pieces near Perry High School with no response. The Board agreed to an Executive Session at the October 19, 2016 meeting for advice on how to proceed. Frank Fletcher will also obtain another appraisal.

CCHS Expansion

Enrollment at Casteel High School is exceeding expectations with more housing underway. Frank Fletcher shared architectural drawings for two options for a 2-story building with 40 typical classrooms. Karen McGee asked about the possibility of a 3-story building. Lana explained the School Facilities Board process in detail.

Wireless Upgrade

Frank Fletcher reminded that the original wireless was installed ten years ago and is in need of upgrading at approximately \$1.8 million. This will include all high schools and junior high schools.

Food Services

Lana Berry explained that for years there had been no systems in place for cost analysis of our Central Kitchen. While putting systems in place she has discovered the facilities are being under-utilized. In order to be most efficient in the operation, administration would like to bring in someone to complete an analysis of operations. Additionally, the procurement side has been moved to the district office purchasing department.

It was decided that a letter would be sent to staff around Veteran's Day thanking them for the patriotic emphasis, reminding of the Kindness emphasis this year and encouraging teachers to use teachable moments to instruct students about our country's heritage.
