



## WINNING WOLVES

Close Up's High School Programs are designed to give students and educators an inside look at their democracy in action. Using the nation's capital as a living classroom, participants get a "close up" view of government - interacting with the people, processes, and places that make this federal city so unique. During the March 23<sup>rd</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> trip, students will visit Washington D.C. and several monuments such as the Arlington Cemetery, President Kennedy's Gravesite, and the Smithsonian's National Air and Space Museum.
