CHS COMPETING IN TEAMS

CHS is sending 35 BC Calculus students to compete in the TEAMS competition at ASU on February 21st. The TEAMS competition is a group challenge, where students complete a two-part exam on topics of science, engineering and mathematics. The first section consists of 80 multiple choice questions, and the second section consists of 5-8 free response essay questions. Students have to work together to solve integrated mathematics problems. Last year, Chandler High had the #1 and #2 teams in the state for our division!

The AIMS Reading Test will be administered on Tuesday, February 25th to

- all 10th grade students
- juniors and seniors who have not yet passed AIMS Reading
- juniors and seniors who signed up to attempt to EXCEED Reading

Students who do not test will be released at 10:00 a.m. on both testing days. Regular bus routes will run at 10:00 a.m. and 2:14 p.m. on both days.

To ensure the integrity of testing, students participating in the test will not be released early and are encouraged to bring a book to read.
