


AP/IB NEWS AND EVENTS

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER CORNER: A MESSAGE FROM OFFICER KEIPERT (SRO)

What a pleasure it is to be back at Chandler High School! I would like to welcome all the new students and families to our campus. I am on campus on most school days from 7:00 a.m. until around 3:00 p.m. if you ever have a need to speak to me. My door is always open. I have a number of duties at Chandler High, and one of the most important, if not THE most important, is to keep your children and the staff safe.

Drop-off and Pick-up:

Please use the drop-off/pick-up system set in place behind the Center for the Arts, which has easy access at Chandler Bl. and California St, to drop off and pick up your students. Do not pull to the nearest curb and let your students out to cross where they want. First, stopping along a curb where stopping/standing/parking is prohibited is an actual offense which could result in a citation. Secondly, it is just plain dangerous for the students. There is an abundance of traffic around the campus in the morning and many drivers are focused on their destination and not cars stopped or people in the street. Finally, if you do choose to drop your students off in a private property location, please make sure they go to the nearest corner to cross the street when safe to do so, not wherever you let them out. Again, other drivers are not looking for people in random locations, but they do notice them on corners. Thanks for making your child's safety a priority.
