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Week of 12/19/16 – Learning in our Classroom

<u>5th Grade Reading</u>: Students will work on reading and vocabulary activities to reinforce concepts covered during the quarter.

<u>Accelerated Reading</u>: The students will be finishing their literature study of <u>Hound Dog True</u> with segments 5-6. We will also be preparing our plays to present to the 5th grade reading classes this week.

<u>Writing</u>: Students will continue with the expository writing unit. They will finish writing their informative essay about the Everglades.

<u>5th Grade Math</u>: The students will continue working in Chapter 7 on "Expressions and Patterns." They will be practicing ordered pairs and graphing. Students will take the Chapter 7 assessment on Wednesday.

<u>Accelerated Math</u>: Students are finishing the chapter on expressions and will take a test on Wednesday. Students should log into their textbook online to use those resources to help with studying. Students can complete the textbook's Chapter Review and email their math teacher their score of 100%. This is a great way to study and to earn a few bonus points toward their study guide.

Tax Credit Contributions Benefit the Fifth Grade

Arizona law ARS 43-1089.01 enables taxpayers a tax credit contribution of up to \$400.00 per calendar year if filing status is Married, filing Joint Return; \$200.00 per calendar year if filing status is Single or Head of Household; and, \$200.00 per calendar year if filing status is Married filing separate return. These contributions can fund extracurricular activities in public schools. It is important to note that a tax credit is a full refund, not a deduction.

Contributions eligible for a tax credit are donated directly to schools, not to the state or the school district. We count on donations to fund our field trips, clubs, and assemblies – just to name a few.
