2-1-1 Housing and Shelter

• Highly recommend calling 211 as this will help match you with the best resources for your family.

What to Expect when you Call 211:

- Families are served on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - *All adults in the household seeking shelter must participate in the screening process to access community resources, including shelter.
- One of the specialists will work with you to understand your situation and help you create a housing plan that includes:
 - Current & Future Stability
 - Community Resources for Income & Housing
 - Connection to Services (including shelter), Depending on Eligibility and Availability

*2-1-1 isn't always a ONE phone call and done- families may need to call daily!

- <u>Family Housing Hub</u> (602) 595-8700
 - The Family Housing Hub provides emergency shelter for families with dependent children in Maricopa County. It serves as a single point of entry for families in need to access resources and get onto the waiting list for shelter.
