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Week of 2/20/17 – Learning in our Classroom

<u>5th Grade Language Arts:</u> Students will move back into their Journeys textbook. We will be reading *LAFFF*. It is a compilation of short stories. Our essential question is: What role does imagination play in the invention process? We will finish up poetry and move into writing persuasive paragraphs. Quad-o-Rama book reports are due Friday, February 24th!

<u>Accelerated Language Arts:</u> Students will continue their menu this week. It focuses on building a government and the U.S. Constitution, which aligns with our social studies unit. We will also continue reading our literature book. Please make sure your child is on pace with the schedule attached to their literature book guide.

<u>5th Grade Math:</u> The students will start to explore rectangular prisms and volume. We will also start to work with finding the area of 2-D shapes with fractional side lengths.

<u>Accelerated Math:</u> Students will be starting a unit on geometry. We will start with area of parallelograms, triangles, and trapezoids.

<u>Science/Social Studies:</u> We are studying the American Constitution in in Social Studies. Students will learn about the three branches of government and The Bill of Rights.
