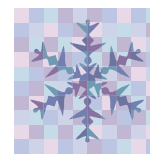

Week of 2/27/17 – Learning in our Classroom

5th Grade Reading: This week, we are focusing on Lesson 18, an autobiography. Students are taking their quiz on Adverbs this week and will learn about prepositions and prepositional phrases. In writing, students are reading 3 article about life in the Old West. They will be doing an opinion writing activity that goes along with the articles.

Accelerated Language Arts: Students will continue their menu this week. It focuses on building a government and the U.S. Constitution, which aligns with our social studies unit. They should be done with the reading portion for their literature book. Students will work on finishing the accompanying comprehension and discussion questions. In writing, students are writing an opinion essay about the Old West.

5th Grade Math: The students will continue to explore chapter 12, which focuses on rectangular prisms and volume.

Accelerated Math: Students will continue learning about area in Chapter 9. They should prepare for their Chapter 9 test, which will be next Friday, March 3rd. To prepare for AzMERIT, students should be accessing their textbook online at home as well as TenMarks and A+ for additional review of 5th grade material.

Science/Social Studies: We will start to read chapter 11 this week, which focuses on westward expansion. The students will fill out a graphic organizer to review the reading.
