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# Week of 1/23/17 – Learning in our Classroom

**Sth Grade Language Arts:** We will be starting a new literature book titled Where the Mountain Meets the Moon by Grace Lin, which is a CUSD required text for 5th grade students. Students will complete a literature log while reading the book. The log contains the dates that each section is due. Please encourage your child to complete the log according to the due dates so the assignments are completed on time. Additionally, we will be focusing on figurative language and poetry throughout this four-week unit. For writing, we will finish up our persuasive essay on science camp activities. **Accelerated Language Arts:** Students will continue a reading menu that goes along with our science unit on the human body. We will also read *Team Moon* from our Journeys program. In small groups, we are reading several informational passages about colds and the flu. For writing, we will finish up our persuasive essay on science camp activities. **5th Grade Math**: We will continue our fraction unit and work on fractions as decimals and then begin adding and subtracting fractions with like denominators.

<u>Accelerated Math</u>: Students will take their Chapter 7 Test on Equations on Thursday. They will want to be sure to study ahead of time with the study guide and the textbook's online resources. After this test, we will begin Chapter 8 on Functions and Inequalities.

<u>Science/Social Studies</u>: We will continue our unit on the Human Body. Students will be studying body systems and functions of the organs.
