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## Learning in our Classroom

<u>5<sup>th</sup> Grade Reading</u>: We will continue to focus on our <u>Frindle</u> literature study. Students should be keeping up with the reading and filling in the literature log by the assigned due dates listed in the packet. We are also working on studying our academic vocabulary words, and will have a quiz over words 5-14 on Friday. <u>Accelerated Reading</u>: The students will be learning about figurative language and reading selections of poetry. They are also beginning a new literature study for <u>Where the Mountain Meets the Moon</u>.

Please check in with your child to make sure he/she is on track with reading.

<u>Writing</u>: Students will learn how to use quality elaboration while expanding their ideas and incorporating new writing techniques.

<u>5<sup>th</sup> Grade Math</u>: The students will begin Chapter 5 in their textbook and learn strategies to add and subtract decimals.

<u>Accelerated Math</u>: We will continue in Chapter 4 where students will be multiplying and dividing fractions. Students should continue to practice their multiplication and division at home to help with this concept.

<u>Science/Social Studies</u>: Students are learning about Forces and Motion. Ask them about the cannon lab that they completed last week. They will learn about balanced and unbalanced forces, work and how it is measured, and simple machines.
