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Week of 10/31/2016 - Learning in our Classroom

<u>5th Grade Language Arts:</u> Students will be finishing reading their literature book *Frindle* this week. The writing prompts in their literature log will be due on Friday. Students are also taking a short test over the book at the end of the week. Students will be studying the last 9 academic vocabulary words for 5th grade. They will be tested on those words on Friday. Students will be expected to know and define all 23 academic vocabulary words, and will continue to be tested on them throughout the year.

<u>Accelerated Language Arts</u>: Students will begin a new menu from their forces and motion unit. We will continue our study of figurative language throughout our literature study of *Where the Mountain Meets the Moon.*

<u>Writing:</u> Students will be working on expository writing strategies, including clarification statements and good examples.

<u>5th Grade Math:</u> In math this week, students will be working on adding and subtracting decimals to the hundredths place. We will also learn about properties of addition.

6th Grade Math: We are continuing to work in Chapter 4. This week, students will be converting measurement units and dividing fractions. As we are nearing the end of the chapter, students should begin to prepare for their Chapter 4 test on Friday by utilizing their textbook's online resources, where they can watch video tutorials and complete self-check quizzes.

<u>Science/Social Studies:</u> Students are continuing to explore Forces and Motion. They will have a quiz on the vocabulary and topics from this unit next week.
