Types of Support

The easiest way to understand the difference between inpatient and outpatient treatment is:

- Individuals in inpatient care live at the treatment facility and receive 24/7 support and supervision.
- Individuals in outpatient care live at home and participate in scheduled supports outlined in their treatment plan.

Arizona Department of Health Definitions

Inpatient Hospitalization

A health care institution that provides continuous treatment to an individual experiencing a behavioral health issue that causes that individual to:

- 1. Have a limited or reduced ability to meet the basic physical needs.
- 2. Suffer harm that significantly impairs the judgment, reason, behavior, or capacity to recognize reality.
- 3. Be a danger to self.
- 4. Be a danger to others.
- 5. Be persistently, acutely, or gravely disabled.
- Inpatient hospitals are primarily engaged in providing diagnosis, treatment, or care of individuals with mental health disorders.

Intensive Outpatient Programs (IOP)

Treatment programs that operate at least three hours a day and at least three days a week used to address addictions, depression, eating disorders, or other dependencies that do not require detoxification or 24-hour supervision.

Crisis Services

If a situation exceeds a person's coping skills, they are in crisis. Crisis services are available to any Arizona resident regardless of health insurance coverage. Services include:

- 24/7/365 crisis telephone lines operated by trained crisis specialists.
- 24/7 mobile teams staffed by behavioral health professionals who travel to the individual experiencing a crisis and provide assessment, stabilization and may triage the individual to a higher level of care, as appropriate.

- Click on Find a Therapist
- Use the drop down to identify what you are looking for:
 - Therapists- mental health providers that provide counseling
 - Psychiatrists- mental health provider that prescribes medication
 - Treatment Centers- specialized facilities to address substance abuse, eating disorders, inpatient treatment, etc
 - Support Groups- individuals with similar challenges that meet together with a mental health provider
- Enter the **City or Zip Code** where you would like to find a provider.
- The search will generate a list of providers. You can **use the tabs to narrow your search**. For example, you could click on insurance and identify that you have United Health Care or click on more and there will be options to identify preferences with language, ethnicity and others.
- **Click on providers** from the results to learn more about them, their practice, costs, insurances accepted, etc.
- Once you find a provider, *contact them* via phone or email to **make an appointment**. Some providers will provide a free consultation to see if it is a good match.
 - Please note there are a variety of professions that are able to provide therapy such as Licensed Professional Counselors (LPC), LMSW (Licensed Master Social Workers), Licensed Marriage & Family Therapist (LMFT).
