

Movie Poster Book Report

Genre: Student Choice Due: February 24th

The Project: Pretend your book is going to be made into a movie. You will create a movie poster to promote the movie.

The Details:

Movie Title: title of the book in large letters

Director: author of the book

Movie Tag Line: a specific phrase that represents the movie

Exs. "An American legend comes to life" or "Save the day" or "Difficult times lie ahead.."

Cast of Characters: actors and their roles

Include the names of the actors that will play the main characters. You can use real actors, make up names, or have friends and family be the actors. You need to include a picture of at least 3 of the characters.

Movie Trailer: Summary

A summary of the book that will make people want to see the movie, but does not give too much away.

Picture: a scene from the movie

This must be hand drawn and show a significant scene from the movie. Do not duplicate the cover of the book.

Critic Reviews:

Include 2-3 reviews from movie critics.

Success Tips For a Successful Project:

- Use a large piece of poster board for your project.
- Choose a book from any genre within your reading level. The book may not be one that is already an actual movie.
- Look at movie posters, DVD covers, and advertisements to get ideas.
- You may write directly on the poster or you may type the elements and glue them to your poster.
- The scene picture must be hand drawn and colored. Other artistic elements may be printed.
- Neatness counts! All written elements must be legible and readable.
- Your poster should be creative and colorful.
