Inappropriate behavior will result in a warning being given to the student. If the behavior doesn't change, parents will be notified. If no change is made in the students behavior then a referral will be given to administration.

TARDIES AND ATTENDANCE

- ◆ Students are expected to be in their seats/on task when the bell rings. If they are not, they will receive a warning. The second occurrence will result in a phone call or e-mail to parents. Every occurrence after the third will result in a referral being sent to the office.
- ◆ **TARDIES ACCUMULATE FOR EACH SEMESTER NOT EACH QUARTER!!**
- ◆ When students are absent, they should check the teacher website and/or contact the teacher for missed work. Students have one day for each day missed to make up the missed work. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT TO TURN IN MISSED WORK.** Work is to be made up whether or not the absence is excused or unexcused. Credit will **NOT** be given for any work (homework, classwork, quizzes or test) missed on an **unexcused** absence.

GRADES AND GRADING

GRADING SCALE: A=100%-90%: B=89.9%-80%: C=79.9%-70%: D=69.9%-60%
