Expand from three lunches to five lunches to reduce numbers in the cafeteria Utilize hand sanitizer and wash hands before lunch The cafeteria lines will be socially distanced and there Follow the arrows and procedures in the cafeteria will be one entrance/exit only Adhere to spacing guidelines on lunch tables, inside and Students will be required to sanitize before entering outside cafeteria Wear masks during the lunch period, except when Lunch time seating will allow for greater than normal sitting and actively eating spacing between students, both inside and outside Participate in appropriate socialization after eating Wearing of masks, when not sitting and eating, will be lunch- normal lunchtime activities will be limited- There enforced in and outside the cafeteria will be no tag, basketball, soccer, or football. NOT share food **AFTER SCHOOL** STUDENT/FAMILY RESPONSIBILITY **SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITY** Students will... Walkers and bike riders will be dismissed 3 minutes early through specific gates on campus Wear masks at dismissal Bus riders will be dismissed at 3:33, leave via the bus Follow dismissal protocols- Walkers and bike riders will gate, and will report immediately to either their bus or dismiss early and from specific gates on campus (you will practice this with your class) bus line Follow bus protocol- Bus riders will immediately load AJHS staff will actively monitor and disperse large bus or join their bus line groups Report immediately to after-school activity locationroom/locker room

#### **Final Thoughts:**

Please note that while we want ALL our students to remain safe and healthy, there is inherent risk when gathering in large groups – like junior high schools. While we will do our best to implement mitigation strategies, there are things we will NOT be able to control:

- Dramatically change adolescent behavior kids are social in nature and they will want to gather and visit
- Ensure social distancing (6 feet of separation) in the classroom, before school, during passing periods, and at lunch

Leave campus immediately after dismissal

• Ensure that our mitigation practices are 100% followed – this is a student responsibility

Warnings for not following our mitigation policies have expired. Noncompliance will result in disciplinary action.
