






2020-2021 COVID Student Expectations

SIMPLEST WAY TO PROTECT THE REALM?

DAILY EXPECTATIONS TO HELP EVERYONE STAY HEALTHY

BEGINNING YOUR DAY

- Bring a cloth mask that covers your mouth and nose. You must wear your mask at all times, except when eating in the designated areas or given the option to remove your mask by a staff member.
- Do not arrive early. Campus will open at 7:15 AM and classes begin at 7:52 AM.
- If your 1st period/2nd period teachers open their rooms in the morning, you may report directly to class. In all other circumstances you will need to stay in the common areas as directed by staff. When the bell rings, you must report to class immediately.

ARRIVING AT CLASS

- Have your mask on prior to walking into class.
- Apply hand sanitizer as you enter the classroom.
- Take your seat immediately and follow the procedures your teacher has set for beginning class.

DURING CLASS

- Follow directions, ask questions, collaborate with peers, and actively engage in learning—this is why we're here!
- Keep your mask in place at all times during class, unless your instructor gives the option to remove it to complete a specific task.
- Be respectful of the personal space of others; keep your hands to yourself and maintain appropriate distance from classmates.
- Try to use the restroom during designated class breaks. Only one student at a time will be permitted to leave class for the restroom. You will be required to sign-out and back in each time you leave the room. Be sure to wash your hands in the restroom and use hand sanitizer when you return to class.

PASSING PERIODS

- *NEW EXPECTATION*: walk directly to your next class and check-in. If the teacher is not present, space out in the designated area. Make sure you arrive to class on time!
- You may use the restroom, but remember only four people may be in the restroom at a time; wait outside the restroom when it is full. Keep in mind that your teacher will allow you to use the restroom during class if needed.

BREAKFAST/LUNCHES

- Apply hand sanitizer as you enter the cafeteria.
- Follow the directions for waiting in line to order – keep your mask on and respect the personal space of others.
- Available seating will be marked in the cafeteria; only three students will be allowed at each outside table.
- You may sit in grassy areas, but must appropriately social distance.
- When you have finished, please clean-up after yourself and sanitize your hands.
- Choose an activity in which you feel comfortable engaging. There will be limits on the physical activities available, but be aware some students may be permitted to remove masks when running in designated areas. You may socialize with friends, but masks should be on when you are not socially distanced.

AFTER SCHOOL

- Students who are picked-up by parents will be dismissed two minutes early. Students will be expected to go directly to the pick-up/drop-off area. Because this area can be crowded, you will need to wear your mask while waiting for the bus, unless you are at least six feet away from other people.
- Students who ride the bus or walk will be released at the bell. Bus riders will be expected to go directly to the bus loading zone. Students who walk will be expected to leave campus immediately.
- Students who participate in after school sports or activities will be released at the bell. Students will be expected to go directly to the assigned area for their activity.
- Unless students are staying for a school activity or homework help, they will be expected to leave campus. Students may not “hang-out” after school.

LIBRARY

- Once the library re-opens, you will need to sign-up for a time prior to accessing the library before school, during lunch, and after school.
- Follow Ms. Parzych’s procedures for entering and exiting the library.
- Wear a mask at all times in the library and sit in designated spots, only.
- Assist in cleaning your area as directed.

HOMEWORK HELP/POWER HOUR

- You will need to sign-up for a time prior to accessing tutoring before and after school. Your teacher will explain the process for sign-up.
- Follow your instructor’s procedures for entering and exiting the cafeteria for power hour or the classroom for homework help.
- Wear a mask at all times and sit in designated seat.
- Assist in cleaning your area as directed.
