Casteel is the only high school in the Chandler school district that offers a four year program ending with the senior design capstone class. Students are able to earn dual credit through Chandler Gilbert Community Collège for the first two years of the program.

Digital Photography

The digital photography career path is expected to grow 4% according to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics. This career path offers students a wide range of ways to into the field as well. 




