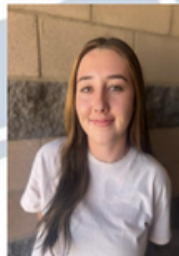

There will be lots of laughter and maybe a few tears as well.





Please come join us for a delightful evening of conversation. You will leave with a much deeper understanding of the reason for the Veterans Day federal holiday. Light refreshments will be available.
