Since the last Round Up, the Cross Country team finished their State meet. On the boys side, the team placed 3rd overall. Joshua Glass placed 10th and Maddox Bonilla placed 18th. Max Crockett finished 31st and Cooper Stoughton finished 33rd. The women's team placed 4th overall. Celedonia Jensen placed 10th, Oliva Jensen placed 17th, and Lucy Schloderback finished 32nd. Outstanding job Colts.

Colts Swim and Dive competed in the AIA State Championships. We had over 20 athletes qualify to compete in Individual, as well as Relay Team events.

Dive had their finals on Thursday and Summer Logas placed 15th in State!

In Swim, we had at least one swimmer qualify for every Individual or Relay Event. Congratulations to the following that made it on the podium, Jaidan Engle took 4th in State in the 100 Backstroke, August Vetsch took 1st in State in the 200 Freestyle and 100 Butterfly, Baylee Sloan took 1st in State in the 200 IM. Our Boys 200 Medley Relay Team took 2nd in State and the Boys 400 Free Relay took 4th in State. August was announced Men's Swimmer of the Year. Both Girls and Boys teams took 7th in State.

Volleyball ended their season on last Wednesday, when they fell to Horizon. It was impressive to see how hard these young athletes worked all season. We know they are destined for great things. We look forward to what the future holds for our Colts.

Football defeated Sandra Day O'Connor on Thursday. They will play Brophy on Friday at Central High School in the next round of the State playoffs. We hope to see you there on Friday night.

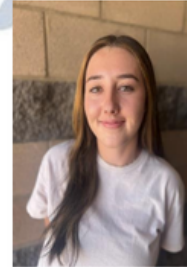
