Students must read literary works and other primary source materials related to the course. Strong writing and research skills are necessary to be successful in this class.

The Common Final will count for $20 \%$ of the student's final semester grade in grades $9-12$ and $10 \%$ in grades $7-8$ (some exceptions may apply at the Junior High level). Common finals will be in ELA, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Language.

Final exams will be given during the CUSD Jr High/High School Early Dismissal days in December and May, as identified on the District Calendar.

If students are requested to participate in a survey, the survey questions will be provided to parents/guardians seven days before student contact.
